

ADVANCED PISTOL/CARBINE/CQB

5 Day Course

Course Overview

Close Quarters Battle (CQB) is the foundation for all tactical operations within a confined area. CQB focuses on points of domination, sectors of fire, speed and accuracy of fire, and accomplishment of mission without collateral damage. Without speed, surprise, and violence of action assaulters will face a prepared defense by the opposition, surely suffering casualties, fatalities, and ultimately mission failure. During CQB, students will utilize advanced shooting skills learned and be taught tactics that permit safe conduct of CQB.

The “combat mind set” is defined as the ability to achieve a complete psychological state of domination and total control of a given situation. It is achieved by training, confidence in your abilities and those of your teammates, and by applying all of the principles and fundamentals of CQB.

Students in this course will be expected to shoot accurately under stressful conditions with both weapons systems. To test the student before they are able to live fire in close proximity to others inside an enclosed structure a specific course of fire will be used to determine the student’s abilities. Stress will be applied through the elevation of the shooter’s heart rate, (slight jog) and by timing the shooter’s activities.

Templar Tactical’s advanced 5 day CQB course is for the operators who already consider themselves CQB qualified. Operators attending this class will be expected to hit the ground running.

The week will be made up of 2 days of advanced shooting drills, followed by 2 days of live fire training runs in the shoot house, and one day of force on force drills.

Topics Covered

- Combat pistol and carbine shooting
- Target recognition and discrimination
- Entry tactics
- Communication during the assault
- Shooting around barricades
- Shooting while on the move
- Shooting with a rifle at distances up to 100m
- Shooting from standing, kneeling, and prone
- Transitioning from one weapon to the other
- Tactical reloads
- Drawing from the holster

Instructors

This course will be taught by former military special operators who specialize in close quarter battle

Ammunition Requirements

1020 rounds of 5.56 Ball (No Green Tip)

1280 rounds of 9mm Ball (Or caliber of secondary weapon)

Ammunition can be purchased from Templar Tactical.

Gear Requirements

Assaulter Vest (including 3A soft armor with Level 4 plates front and back), (4) M4 magazine pouches, pistol magazine pouch that holds (3) magazines, (1) flash bang pouch, level 3 ballistic helmet, hearing and eye protection, inclimate weather gear, drop holster for secondary weapon, primary weapon sling, gloves, and tactical clothing.

Certain gear items are available for purchase in the pro shop. Vests and armor are available for rental.

Weapon Requirements

Primary weapon system (M4 or SubGun) with (5) 30 round magazines, optics are optional

Secondary weapon with (4) high capacity magazines

Weapons are available for rental.

Prerequisites

Advanced CQB skill set. Stress test must be passed prior to student being able to enter the live fire shoot house.

Students will be taught and refreshed on the above skills during the first 2 days of training. The stress test will be given on the third morning of training with a retest given to those who don't meet the standards on points. If a student does not meet the standard on the second attempt they will be allowed to continue in training but will only fire Simunition FX Marking Catridges within the shoot house. The standards that TT applies for its advanced CQT courses are not designed to fail or embarrass the students. They are in place to ensure the safety of all parties involved. The standards are a baseline and fairly easy to achieve. The test includes all of the topics covered in the above section as well as running in full kit up to 50 yards prior to firing.
